Mr. Roy Chaffey was born in 1938 in Bournemouth, then Hampshire now Dorset, England, he grew up in Wimborne, Dorset. He was a student at Queen Elizabeth's Grammar School in Wimborne, Dorset from 1950 -1954. His first job was at Flight Refueling, Tarrant, Rushton, Dorset from June 1954 until 1963, initially as a Hangar Trainee and completing his employment as an Engineering Draftsman. In 1963 he attended Garnett College in London and successfully completing a course in Theory and Practice of Education, and on graduation took the position of Metalwork Teacher at Northern Grammar School in Portsmouth, Hampshire. In 1984 Roy was the General Manager of Carrier Ontario Distributors which lasted two years, after this he took a career change when he was offered the position of Teaching Professor in School for the Building Environment at Humber College (North Campus) Rexdale, Ontario. Roy was a member of ASHRAE since 1974, and past president with the Toronto Chapter for the years 1990 -1991, and prior to that he served many of the Chair and Board of Governors positions with the Chapter. Roy was married to his wife Kathleen since 1962 and they had two sons Michael and Stephen. Roy was very proud of his children and even more proud of his grandchildren Caitlin and Thomas.
